Certificates

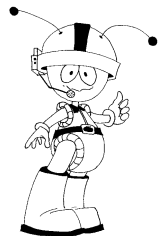
Professional development certificates will be available after the closing address on Saturday in the Zero-G Diner.

A bus is available for presenters needing access to the Gilruth. Please inquire at the conference Help Table or with Angela in the bus area.

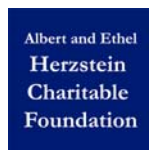
2011 Conference Dates
